keep a safe distance away from others (1.5 to 2.5 meters), on the street, in the supermarket, pharmacy and in the park and will follow the local rules as stipulated.

respect the elderly and help where we can, but not in a way that will put them in harms way of the virus.

not pass on false information or miracle cures, but instead will point each and everyone to the local, state and country specific task forces that are leading this fight against the Coronavirus.
